Frenchie's Kitchen to You

Seasoned Red Onions

With Vinaigrette & Red Wine Sauce

Slice 1 large red onion into 1/2 inch rings

In a bowl combine:

1/4 cup olive oil

1 1/2 cup red wine vinegar

add 1/4 teaspoon each: coarse salt, black pepper, dill seed, coriander seed, garlic powder

Stir in onion, mix well, refrigerate for 1 hour before serving

Serve over a slice (3/8" to 1/2" thick) tomato
